New Changes to Library's Teen Area

Thanks to a generous grant provided to the Hudson Library by the Wendell Petersen Charitable Trust, we are making changes to update the Teen Area. All young adult materials formerly housed in the upstairs Teen room have been relocated downstairs. The collection of young adult titles can now be found in the space formerly occupied by the public computers, past the circulation desk. New shelving has arrived to house the manga collection, graphic novels, as well as new young adult books. Young adult nonfiction books remain upstairs, mixed in with the adult nonfiction. Upstairs in the former Teen area, the Library has added a new TV, for playing the Library's collection of Nintendo Switch games. The Switch and its game collection can be checked out for in-library use at the Youth Services desk. Board games are also available upstairs.
